

UNION WIN: K&S BACKS DOWN - NEGOTIATIONS TO COMMENCE

Negotiations have started this week after we have successfully challenged K&S to renegotiate enterprise agreements in South Australia and Northern Territory by dragging them through the Fair Work Commission.

We need to continue to hold K&S to **account over their conduct in bargaining:** pushing through agreements without involving the union and threatening workers if they involve the union.

This is a huge win for workers at K&S. TWU members and delegates stood firm and rejected K&S' attempt to weaken us at the bargaining table. Your member-led bargaining team can now stand united and get on with negotiating our agreement to improve your terms and conditions.

PREPARE TO BARGAIN

- We're back on the bargaining table. In surveys, yard and delegate meetings, TWU members made it clear that they're ready to stand together for **a national agreement** and to **close the gap** in pay and conditions with the rest of the industry.
- Your member-led TWU bargaining team will provide further updates on the progress of our negotiations with K&S.

TWU members have made it clear at K&S that it is time for:

- ✓ **One national agreement**
 - To improve outcomes for all K&S workers across Australia. K&S does not want workers to get a fair deal, and that's why our unity matters.
- ✓ **Close the gap with fairer pay and conditions**
 - We're fighting to close the gap between you and transport workers at other companies who are paid up to 40% above the Award.
