

SWISSPORT MUST REIMBURSE MEMBERS FOR SAFETY BOOTS

Swissport has been **forcing workers to pay** for their own mandatory safety boots while pocketing the savings.

SafeWork NSW has issued an Improvement Notice confirming Swissport failed to provide the PPE needed to protect workers from crushing and falling objects. If we need to, we will pursue this in every state until Swissport are forced to comply with the law. Workers should never have been left to cover the cost of their own workplace safety.

We have formally demanded that **Swissport reimburse every affected worker \$200** for safety footwear purchased while working at Swissport bases where boots were not provided. Swissport have run out of places to hide, and piece by piece we will hold them to account.

Swissport has until 27 August 2026 to pay up.



If Swissport refuses to reimburse workers, TWU will investigate all available enforcement options, including the prosecution of Swissport under work health and safety laws.

Don't let Swissport get away with pushing the cost of safety onto workers.

Join the TWU to be part of the fight.

Together, we can make Swissport pay workers back for every dollar they should never have had to spend on mandatory safety boots. These fights are possible because hundreds and hundreds of workers have already joined. Let's make this fight for change even stronger.



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
