

PREPARE TO TAKE ACTION



PFD members have been pledging action around the country to send a clear message to PFD: workers will not be forced into another agreement that **leaves them behind** the rest of the industry.

We've lodged a Protected Action Ballot (PAB), giving members the opportunity to vote on taking protected industrial action if PFD continues refusing to negotiate a fair deal.

By voting yes to all questions in the PAB, you're building pressure on PFD to Close the Gap in pay and conditions in a consolidated EA.
