

BARGAINING RESUMES: TWU LOG OF CLAIMS TABLED

After QUBE failed to reach an agreement with workers, drivers in Moranbah, Moura and Gracemere have appointed the TWU as their bargaining representative.

Negotiations have now recommenced, with your TWU member-led team putting forward a Log of Claims for a fairer agreement.

The previous agreement was voted down after QUBE put forward an offer that included no pay increase for 2025. Drivers have said that isn't good enough, and now we're back at the negotiating table.
