Jetstar Cabin Crew Update

More international flying opportunities? Tell us what you're seeing.

TWU delegates recently met with Jetstar to continue pushing for better access to international flying opportunities for Australian-based crew.

At our previous meeting, delegates put two key proposals to Jetstar:

- 1 Work with TWU delegates during pairing reviews** to create more trips that start from Australian bases and increase access to lucrative international flying for Australian crew.
- 2 Consider expanding TJI positions** into the Adelaide base during the next TJI recruitment intake.

Jetstar has now reported back on the steps it says it is taking, including:

Changes to roster construction and flying distribution

Increased communication and consultation with crew

A review of standby practices

Better sharing of desirable and less desirable duties

Improved access to 787 flying across crew groups

Roster quality improvements and better day-off outcomes

But the real question is: Is it making a difference?

Are you seeing improvements in access to international flying, roster quality, take-home pay? Or are crew concerns still going unaddressed?

We want to hear from you.

TWU delegates are gathering feedback directly from crew to understand whether these changes are working and what more needs to be done.
